

Finding the Flower Show page

Flower Show Schedule - (Rulebook of the flower show)



Division II Horticulture Form – Use to organize Division 2 Horticulture entries you will eventually submit online.

Entry Forms to Download – If you really need a paper form for Divisions I and III, this is where you find them. No paper entry form for Division IV, link to online form only.

Submit Online Entries - All entries ***eventually*** must be submitted online. This helps us to print the entry cards.

How to Submit Entries to Division II-Horticulture

1. Click on the **Division II Horticulture Form** button to download and print the Division II Horticulture Form. This will help you organize all your entries.
2. Next, click on the **Flower Show Brochure**. Brochure will help you fill out the form.
3. List the plants you wish to enter in Division II on one sheet, 2 if you need more room.

4. After you complete the Division II Horticulture form, return to the Flower Show page (link below)

5. Use the form to enter the required information into the flower show data base.


1. Download **Division II Horticulture Form**.

Suggestions to determine plant Genus and species name

Genus and species name is required on all Division II entry cards **EXCEPT** Section G Combination Plantings. With over 500 entries in Division II alone, we do not have time to find missing information.

1. Take a picture of the plant and go to your favorite nursery.
2. Take a picture of the plant and send it to your circle members.
3. "Google" it. Open Google or Chrome on your phone and look for the camera icon. Press the camera icon and take a picture.



4. Use a plant app from your phone.

Submitting Online Entries

1. Have your *entry form* (any entry form) in front of you.
 2. On the TGC [Flower Show page](#) click on the **Submit Online Entries** button.
 3. The PDF document (example on right) has the links to every online entry form in each Division, Section, and Class.
 4. Find the link you need and click.
 5. Complete the information required and **SUBMIT**.
- A copy of your responses will be emailed to the address you provided.
6. Online entries are *immediately* available to the Flower Show committee to view.
 7. Repeat steps 1-6 for each flower show entry.
